to Hopeman Bros. -

- Hopeman was aware of the label situation -
- When Panels were received - they ran into trouble taking them off the Marinide panels - and have claimed an a 2. & 5. report it took up to 10 minutes (8-10) to remove labels - using a putty knife - & final hand sanding - using a hot iron - which drove the contact of the label into the Marinide - therefore requested no more labels - the 2. & 5 is still pending -

- We met - the lawyers & had approved the use of a red-ink - rubber stamp application of the same wording of the label. This is currently being done on Marine Panels from Bellica -

- AVM Corp. heard of this problem & requested same treatment - & threatened to cancel their ± 4000 sheet Marinide order -

This label is being used on Marine Panels from Nashua only. (Marine Veneer) - applied to the back of panels -
