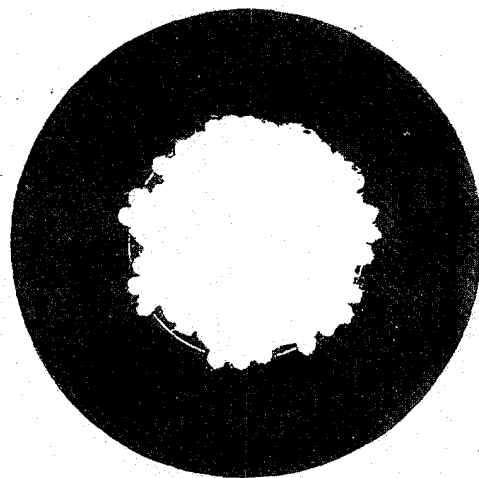




670 Shots—All 10's

DURING the 1927 indoor matches of the Metropolitan Rifle League, eighty-two possibles were scored. Sixty-seven of these possibles—84% of them—were shot by riflemen using U. S. .22 N.R.A.'s.
