this man.

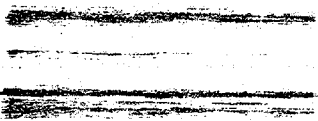
Laboratory data show only that the amount of

Conclusions and Recommendations

This man is in excellent physical and mental
health and the above mentioned lead increase is not sufficient
to produce disease in this man. We recommend that he avoid

working in extremely dusty atmospheres, particularly within
the confines of boxcars.
