Dear Sir,

Following recent inspections of your mine workings and after reading a report made by one of our Ventilation Officers, I must request that continued attention be given to laying dust in all underground places by the use of water. Dust counts are relatively high and must be brought to a minimum.

I know that it is your desire to keep your fibre as dry as possible, however this consideration must be given low priority regarding the health of workers.

I must therefore instruct that all working places be issued with a hose so that all broken dirt, backs and walls may be wetted.
