ZINC OXIDE:

We acknowledge receipt of your telegram of the 7th inst., requesting us to rush shipment of Green and Red Seal also Leaded Zinc ordered March 4th.

We are pleased to advise that the Red and Green Seal Zinc went forward on April 6th. Thirty three tons of the 5% Leaded was shipped on April 1st.

At the time order was placed, the New Jersey Zinc Co. stated that the best they could do on this grade would be to ship equal quantities during the months of April, May and June. This would mean that another shipment would not be made until May 1st.

On receipt of your telegram, we took up the matter with them, telling them of your urgent need and they have promised to ship another car of the Leaded early next week, completing the order as rapidly as possible.

We are therefore wiring you, as per copy of night letter enclosed, giving you the above information.
