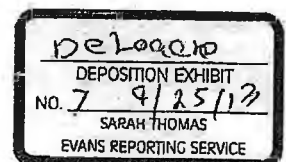
Whenever possible, GRP panels of 25 or 50 flame spread or plywood will be used as substitutes for corrugated ACB. Flexboard II is a non-asbestos cement board and is an acceptable substitute for flat ACB. Flexboard II is not available in corrugated form.

Elimination of the sale of ACB components is predicated on our inability to insure potential liabilities for Marley Cooling Tower Company as a member of the chain of supply of such components to final users. Please advise if there are any questions.
