I apologize for the short notice, but I am hoping you may have a few moments on Tuesday afternoon to meet with CRIT tribal council members Granthum Stevens, Bobby Page, and JD Fisher. As Pam (cc'd) is aware, CRIT is in the process of working on a proposal to implement large scale conservation measures on the reservation and make conserved water available for lease to off reservation water users. We would like to make you aware of the proposal and solicit any feedback you may have early on in the process. Additionally, we would like to discuss ways CRIT can continue to participate in the Department's ongoing efforts to improve the overall health Colorado river system. With more than 600,000 acre feet of water rights, we can play a large role in helping to build flexibility and sustainability into the system.
