Part of body examined THORAX AND G.I. TRACT

X-RAY REPORT

Heart and lungs are normal.

Esophagus is not obstructed or deformed.

A plain view of the abdomen presents no abnormal shadows. Liver, spleen, kidneys, and pancreas are in normal position and not enlarged.

Stomach and duodenum are in normal position, shape, and size. No filling defects are noted in the contour. Peristalsis is of moderate degree and empties at a moderate rate. 24 hours later colon is partially filled. Appendix is irregularly filled, but no tenderness upon pressure.

Barium enema revealed no obstruction or deformity in the entire course of the colon.

CONCLUSION: NO ORGANIC LESION IS DEMONSTRABLE.
