ORDER FROM SUPPLIER AS - Asbestos-Sponge Felted Sheet, stating size and thickness.

CHARACTERISTICS - A flexible, laminated, fibrous, asbestos sheet, sheeting resembling corrugated cardboard in appearance and flexibility, and so constructed to contain a large number of laminated air cells. Available in sheets 36 inches long by 12, 18, 24, and 36 inches wide by 1/2 to 4 inches thick. Usually obtained in sheets 36 by 24 by 1 inch thick. Density about 30 lbs per cubic foot. Temperature use limit 371 C (700 F).

APPLICATION - Used as a liner for metal jacket turbine covers to prevent the turbine heat from burning the paint from the outside surfaces of the jacket.
