I'm just writing to express my disappointment with the way the EPA handled their response to the AP article on Superfund sites (part of the response was signed by Liz Bowman). I urge your agency to take a more professional--and less personal--response in the future. Perhaps you could have indirectly replied with a lengthy statement saying what the EPA was doing on the ground after Harvey, rather than pursuing a journalist.

That would make me--as a single mom worried about the future of my son's environment--more assured. I am increasingly upset--and feel increasingly powerless--with the actions of this agency, one who, under this administration, is prioritizing short-term business gains. Might you consider a name change for transparency reasons? BPA? Business Protection Agency? It may not help the panic and upset I feel, but would at least be honest.
