We have approximately 2,400 used Oxy-cat bricks in surplus at El Paso Refinery. These bricks, which had been reprocessed by Oxy-Catalyst, Inc., were obtained in July, 1959, in exchange for our used bricks on Purchase Order ESN-29510 for approximately \$13,400. They were used in our HCC Oxy-cat burner from July, 1959, until the burner was dismantled in January, 1961. Oxy-Catalyst, Inc., is not interested in repurchasing the used bricks.

We see no likelihood of using these bricks at El Paso and plan to scrap them unless you have some suggestion of a use.

MR. M. P. PARET, JR.:

Please refer to your letter of March 21, 1963 to Mr. W. K. Venatta on the above subject.

Our efforts to make arrangements with Grange Chemicals Limited in England to have them purchase a spare charge of Oxy Cat bricks for their fume incinerator furnace through Oxy-Cat Inc. in Berwyn, Pennsylvania have failed. Calchem is a one-third owner in Grange Chemicals Limited and we had hoped that the surplus El Paso bricks could have been returned to Oxy-Cat as part of an exchange agreement for new bricks to be ordered by Grange. Oxy-Cat had, as a matter of fact, offered a credit of \$3.25 for each surplus brick f.o.b. Berwyn, Pennsylvania for every new brick ordered through their Berwyn office.

Grange Chemicals ordered their bricks, however, through Oxy-Cat, France which firm is licensed by Oxy-Cat, U.S. to sell their bricks in Europe. Unfortunately, Oxy-Cat, U.S. has no control over Oxy-Cat, France in matters concerning placement of orders.

We understand that Mr. Klarquist's office in San Francisco is aware of the situation. Mr. Klarquist will alert other operating companies to the surplus bricks available at El Paso and Oxy-Cat's offer to accept the surplus bricks against any orders for new bricks made through their Berwyn office.
