The Technical Report dated June 28, 1968 by Mr. H. L. Byrd recommending that we review our respirators worn by some employees. We have in stock Mine Safety Appliances respirators, Dustfree #66. We encourage our employees to wear these respirators. We think this is the best, but we also have others which are much lighter in weight and more comfortable to wear. Some employees will wear these but will not wear the others. We have not forced our employees to wear respirators because they either quit or just wear them when we are looking at them. We encourage them to wear them, but due to the tight labor market we do not force the issue.
