INFORMATION FOR TOSCA REPORT

1. "Calidria" Asbestos

Refined chrysotile asbestos ore containing in excess of 90% chrysotile fiber with the remainder being naturally occurring impurities.

Includes, but may not be limited to, UCC designations SG-100, SG-101, SG-102, SG-103, SG-104, SG-130, SG-200, SG-210, HPP, HPO, RG-100, RG-110, RG-144, Visbestos, Supervisbestos, and Imco Shur-lift, SG-310, AS-200, HPP-EX, HPO-EX, RG-110-EX, SX-14, SG-100-EX, SG-102-EX, and SG-130-EX.

Tonnage in 1977 - 23,439

2. Amorphous Silica-Treated "Calidria" Asbestos Products

"Calidria" asbestos as defined in Item 1 combined with 3-10% by weight of amorphous silica.

Includes UCC designations RG-244, SX-24 and RG-244-EX.

Tonnage in 1977 - 1, 149

3. Titanated "Calidria" Asbestos Products

"Calidria" asbestos as defined in Item 1 combined with 25-35% by weight of rutile or anatase titanium dioxide.

Includes, but is not limited to, UCC designations T-135-0, T-135-P, CG-135-P, CG-135-0, T-135-0-EX, T-135-P-EX.

Tonnage in 1977 - 304

4. Phenolic Resin-Treated "Calidria" Asbestos Products

"Calidria" asbestos as defined in Item 1 combined with 5-10% by weight of dimethylol-t-butyl phenol.

UCC designation - RG-600.

Tonnage in 1977 - 12.5

5. Silane-Treated "Calidria" Asbestos Products

Amorphous silica-treated "Calidria" asbestos products as defined in Item 2 combined with 3-10% by weight of octyl triethoxy silane.

Tonnage in 1977 - 0
