I am submitting a copy of a June 13, 1989 letter received from John J. Larsen, Jr., attorney. The specific request is that future checks be made payable to I think it would be appropriate that the checks be payable to her, as widow of Deceased. In talking with Larsen he asked that the checks come regularly, and I would suggest they be sent in four week increments.

The other matter I have talked to him about is the possibility of lumping out the future benefits. I discussed that in the fourth paragraph of my letter to you of March 29, 1989. Larsen tells me that would be interested. If Sherwin Williams is also, we should discuss at what level to start a negotiation.

It should be stated here that the Workers' Compensation Act does state that in the event of the remarriage of a widow, without children, she shall at that point be paid a lump sum equal to two years compensation benefits, however all further rights are then extinguished. In other words we would be buying a pig-in-a-poke if she has any plans to remarry.
