

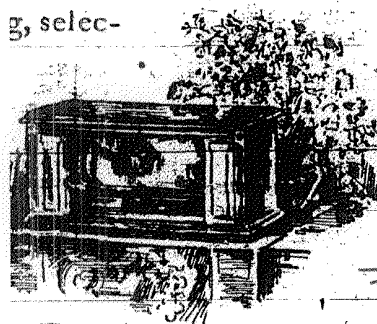

LONDON, (AP).—Builders who are competing for the honor of planning the best "middle-class" house are having a hard time trying to decide what "middle-class" is.

Not long ago Lady Rhondda, a peeress in her own right, a business woman of marvelous skill and probably the richest woman in Great Britain, declared she belongs to the "middle-class."

On the other hand wealthy business men who waxed fat during the war are resenting the implication that they belong to the "middle class" and declare that it is a badge of inferiority.

The "middle-class" seems to be such an indefinite term in Great Britain that the forthcoming Building Trades Exposition, in Birmingham, where the ideal "middle-class" houses are to be shown, is awaited with interest.

Dawes Plan Effect To Date Announced

BERLIN, (AP).—Since September 1, 1924, when the Dawes Plan went into effect, Germany has executed 11,250 delivery contracts. She has sent to her former enemies goods to the value of 892,000,000 marks.

The principal deliveries went to France, 4,878 contracts being executed at a value of 496,000,000 marks. France received around 103,000,000 marks worth of synthetic nitrates and artificial fertilizer, besides a million marks worth of timber, paper, cattle, machinery and sugar.

Belgium came next with 106,000,000 marks worth of goods, chiefly chemicals. Italy received mainly machinery. Rumania and Jugoslavia mostly metal, Greece cattle, and Portugal electrical apparatus.

Besides the Dawes deliveries, there were special dyestuffs delivery agreements with France, Belgium and Italy, to a total value of 23,000,000 marks.
