Bynum Turner spent two days with us in Detroit last week reviewing our various programs. As you can imagine, one of the programs which we discussed at some length was that on tetramethyllead.

During the discussions it became evident that there are quite a few gaps in our background, and on the regulations in existence at the present time in various countries outside of the United States as to the use of tetraethyllead. As you know, we have received a number of inquiries lately from some of our customers as to what might be expected in various countries with regard to the procedure on getting proper clearance to use tetramethyllead. Since you are the only person with this background, I wonder if we could presume upon your busy schedule to ask you to dictate a brief resume' of the status of tetraethyllead in the major countries outside the United States and what, in your opinion, would be the procedure if and when it would be appear to be desirable to get approval of the use of tetramethyllead.
