Dear Sir:

I have a copy of your letter of May 30 addressed to the Medical Department, Ethyl Corporation, 405 Lexington Avenue, New York City, concerning the possibility of poisoning following exposure to concentrated tetraethyl lead fluid. If your exposure has been terminated, it is unlikely that harmful effects will occur, since tetraethyl lead is readily eliminated spontaneously from the body.

I am sure the medical officer in charge is thoroughly familiar with the toxicologic properties of tetraethyl lead and can advise you accordingly.
