Pharming - a new term for misdirecting users to fraudulent sites or proxy servers. "Pharmerms" plant malicious software in your computer or poison servers that direct traffic on the Internet. Besides keeping anti-virus and anti-spyware programming up to date on your PC, users have other ways to defend themselves from pharming. Any site that conducts financial transactions should display a padlock symbol in the lower right corner of the screen, and the web address should begin with "https," not "http."
