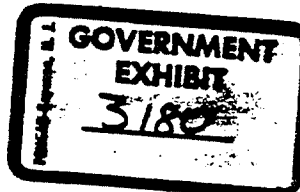
If at a later date it is the Committee's desire to reopen either of these memorandums you will be so informed.
