Blue asbestos clue
to five deaths

FIVE WOMEN have died in Nottingham from a form of cancer linked with asbestos after they spent time while working in a mine during the war.

All had been living stress-
tolerant, "readable" (blue

Asbestos, which was once the most common of the lung dust diseases known as the portland cements, now takes second place in mortality with about 40 cases being diagnosed each year. It would, however, be a grave mistake, to underestimate the significance of asbestos and the plight of its victims.
