Dear Dr. Müller:

I have been informed recently become medical consultant for Corporation in Norway. I take this of your acquaintance through correspondence myself at your disposal as a source of information you may require.

I should appreciate if you would communicate with me from time to time if questions arise in the medical situation with respect to leaded gasoline in Norway. I am not sure of the status of the situation in Norway. Last time there were no activities.

The general policy developed with regard to the handling of lead in this field is based on quite a number of years experience in this country. From such experience we know that if the mixing equipment is properly maintained if it is kept in order, and if the work is done in accordance with the Regulations, there is no danger for illness or even for measureable lead exposure. It has been our purpose to plan the whole work so as to avoid significant lead exposure. Therefore, this should not be done. Accordingly, we have developed a mechanism for assuring our set of equipment is constructed properly and is so policed as to maintain it in proper condition. From this point of view, the chief function of consultants is to promote continuous vigilance for safety, and to detect any evidences of inadequacy in carrying on the work. We have followed the policy of selecting only young, healthy and reasonably intelligent men, and these men by means of careful physical examination detect any evidences of lead absorption or illness of any kind develops among them. We have advised the use of any measures which are necessary in arriving at a clean-cut diagnosis. If
