To Companies Cooperating on Form F,
Domestic Mine Labor Report;

For nearly five years the Association has been publishing monthly Report Form F, Domestic Mine Labor, on which you have been cooperating, and for which cooperation we are deeply appreciative. We believe that this report proved most helpful, not only to the Association and to the Government, but to the companies reporting on it, during the wartime and postwar period of labor shortages.

A question has now been raised by one of our member companies as to the present value of this report because of changed labor supply conditions. The Association is always anxious to minimize the work of reporting statistics on the part of members and other cooperating companies and desires to discontinue publication of any reports which are of no, or doubtful, value.
