This AGREEMENT, effective 3-15-81, between Sun Petroleum Products A Division of Sun Oil Company of Pennsylvania hereinafter called "Owner", having an office at 1608 Walnut Street Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19103 and the "Contractor" shown above

WITNESS In consideration of the mutual promises herein made, Owner and Contractor agree as follows:
ARTICLE 1 - THE WORK: The work shall consist of To furnish supervision, labor, material, tools and equipment as required and requested by an approved P.O. release No. to perform electrical maintenance and construction services on a (24) twenty four hr/day basis as directed by a designated SPFC representative. (No services will be performed on overhead lines and transmission substations.)

Contractor shall perform all work hereunder in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Contract and the following as noted:

(X) 2. Specifications () by Eddie Brinkman.
(X) 3. Work Description ()
(X) 4. Safety and Security Requirements ()

This Agreement, including Articles 1 through 8, the Field Services General Terms and Conditions on the reverse side hereof, and the Exhibits attached hereto or referenced herein shall constitute the Contract between the parties.

ARTICLE 2 - MATERIALS, PERSONNEL AND SUBCONTRACTS: Contractor shall furnish any and all labor, supervision, permits (unless otherwise stated herein to the contrary), machinery, equipment, tools, fuel, supplies, facilities, materials, transportation and all other things necessary for the performance and completion of all work authorized hereunder, except such items noted to be specifically supplied by Owner as follows:

Owner reserves the right to provide labor or material at its option.

Unless, otherwise specified, all materials to be furnished by Contractor shall be new and of a grade and quality which conforms to Owner's Standards, if such apply; otherwise such material must be suitable for the use intended

ARTICLE 3 - COMPENSATION: For satisfactory performance of the work hereunder, Owner agrees to pay Contractor in the manner and at times hereinafter specified, and Contractor agrees to accept as full and complete payment for providing such work, compensation as follows:

All invoices will be documented by daily/weekly time sheets and approved by an SPFC representative. Invoices must show this Contract No. PS400-81-5 and release no. or work order no.

ARTICLE 4 - MANNER AND TIMES OF PAYMENT:

Contractor will present Owner with a documented invoice at the completion of each Contract release.

Prior to final payment hereunder, and as a condition thereto, Contractor shall satisfy the requirements of Clause 14 of the Field Services General Terms and Conditions on the reverse side hereof

ARTICLE 5 - TERM: Work under this Contract shall commence on or about 3-15-81 All work performed at the site shall be on the basis of Contractor's standard work week as set forth by local agreement. No overtime shall be worked, except for spot overtime, unless approved by the Owner in writing. All work, including testing shall be complete on or before 3-14-82

ARTICLE 6 - CHANGES, ADDITIONS AND/OR DELETIONS: Owner reserves the right, from time to time, to make changes, additions and/or deletions to the work as it may deem necessary. All changes, additions or deletions shall be made in writing and accepted by both parties before Contractor proceeds with such work. Contractor shall make no changes, additions or deletions to the work without Owner's prior written instructions. The cost of such changes, additions or deletions shall be determined as follows:

As negotiated

This Contract may be cancelled by either party with a thirty (30) days written notice.

Contractor shall make no changes in the Schedule of work to be performed hereunder, extending completion beyond the date shown in Article 5 above, without prior written approval of Owner.

ARTICLE 7 - INSURANCE: During the performance of all work hereunder, Contractor shall take out, carry and maintain in insurance company or companies, and in policies of insurance acceptable to Owner, the following insurance with limits not less than indicated for the respective items:

- Workers' Compensation and Occupational Disease Insurance, including Employer's Liability, complying with laws of the state in which the work is to be performed or elsewhere as may be required. Employer's Liability Insurance shall be provided with a limit not less than \$1,000,000
- Comprehensive General Liability Insurance, including Contractual Liability and Products-Completed Operations Liability and Explosion, Collapse and Underground Damage liability as well as coverage on all Contractor's equipment (other than motor vehicles licensed for highway use) owned, hired or used in performance of this contract with limits not less than:
 - \$1,000,000 Bodily Injury & Property Damage Combined each occurrence and aggregate
 - \$1,000,000 Bodily Injury & Property Damage Combined each occurrence and aggregate
- Automobile Liability Insurance, including Contractual Liability, covering all motor vehicles owned, hired or used in the performance of this contract, with limits not less than \$1,000,000
- Builders Risk Insurance: The Builders Risk Insurance coverage applicable to this contract is checked below. For definition of applicable coverage see Clause 22 of Field Services General Terms and Conditions on the reverse side of this form. ☐ ☐

ADDENDUM TO SPPC PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CONTRACT NO. PS400-81-582.

THIS AGREEMENT, effective this 1st, day of March, 1981, between Sun Petroleum Products Company, A division of Sun Oil Company of Pennsylvania, a Corporation having an office for the transaction of business at Suntide Road - Corpus Christi, Texas hereinafter called "OWNER" and Burns International Security Services Inc. a Delaware Corporation having a office for the transaction of business at (Petroleum Towers, Suite 502, Corpus Christi, Texas 78401) hereinafter called "CONTRACTOR", is to be a part of and an addendum to the SPPC Professional Service Contract No. PS400-81-582.

WHEREAS, the Owner desires to have the Contractor furnish uniformed guards for the protection of the Owner's premises located at Suntide Road, Corpus Christi, Texas and in consideration of the mutual promises herein made, Owner and Contractor agree as follows:

1. Contractor shall furnish Owner with armed guards, completely outfitted with uniforms and necessary equipment, including side arms and badges for the protection of Owners property. The specific number of guards, principal posts and hours of duty to be agreed upon between the parties from time to time.
2. All work shall be performed in such a manner as to cause a minimum of interference with Owner's operations and the operations of other contractors on the premises. Contractor shall take all necessary and proper precautions to protect the premises and all persons and property thereon from damage, loss or injury.
3. Contractor shall not enter into agreements applicable solely to the providing of work and services hereunder with various labor organizations employed in the work which increase labor rates, or working hours, of the work force without prior written approval of Owner.
4. For the services rendered and equipment furnished by the Contractor, the Owner agrees to pay the Contractor in accordance with the rates as follows:

The Owner will pay the Contractor at the overtime (O.T.) rate for each of Contractors's employees who works in excess of forty five (45) hours per week.

5. The Contractor agrees that it will use its best efforts to provide such additional guards and related personnel as may be requested by the Owner to maintain order by reason of a strike by Owner's employees, civil disturbance, riot or any similar emergency requiring and increase in the number of guards at such rates as shall be mutually agreed upon by parties. Owner agrees to give Contractor not less than 24 hours notice of its requirements for additional guards for such purpose.

6. The rates set forth in paragraph (4) above shall prevail for one (1) year, however, in the event of any change in any federal or

ce legislation or regulation effecting any change in the hours of service provided under this Agreement such rates shall be subject to adjustment by the Contractor in accordance with any actual changes occurring in the bare labor rates (guard rate). Any such revised rates will not become effective until Contractor has provided Owner with thirty (30) days written notice prior to change.
