Jack,

Most sincere apologies. This meeting is primarily focused on whether API BZ TG will broaden its scope to include more than just tox work and who will represent Shell. I simply offered CAA RR as an example of an issue that the TG might be willing to explore if the scope is broadened. You are a key member of the Shell BZ CAA RR team and the team would certainly decide together how best to progress an industry approach to benzene. There is a meeting of the API BZ TG on Feb 23 for the first time in over a year. They have gone almost inactive since the Shanghai Study started. This is a "resuscitation" meeting with a discussion around whether to broaden the scope of the TG to work benzene issues generally and not just tox. I do not expect anything more from the meeting. If the TG gives a green light to a bigger scope of work, then we will start thinking more detailed about how to structure potentially a CAA RR effort.
