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TOXICOLOGICAL PROPERTIES OF STYRENE AND VINYLIDINE CHLORIDE

Attached is a summary of the general information available in our office concerning the Toxicology of Styrene and Vinylidine Chloride.

Renal and hepatic damage is listed along with other effects which might be expected from inhalation exposure to styrene. Toxicological properties of Vinylidine Chloride are indicated as being similar to those of Carbon Tetrachloride.
