

LEAD POISON OF GASOLINE KILLS MAN

*Retired Navy Officer Dies
After Getting Mouthful of
Fluid From Hose*

SAN DIEGO, May 7 (AP)—Lead poisoning, assertedly contracted as a result of an attempt to siphon a brand of ethyl gasoline from his automobile, caused the death today of Lieut. [REDACTED] United States Navy. [REDACTED] became ill shortly after getting a mouthful of fluid from the hose he was using as a siphon. He was taken to the Naval Hospital, where his illness was diagnosed as lead poisoning. He retired from the Navy a year ago after serving a tour of duty in Samoa.
