A report on the industrial hygiene survey of the Pittsburgh Plate Glass Company's Creighton plant has been prepared. Some preliminary patch testing has been completed and will be reported later.

The animal exposure has been continued. One animal died after 20 minutes exposure to the gases produced by the reaction. The first eye examination did not disclose any pathology but sufficient time has not elapsed to produce measureable results.

The Industrial Hygiene Digest for August has been prepared and the stencils are being cut for mimeographing.
