Warren today signed a bill by Assemblyman Earl D. Desmond of Sacramento which permits "for hire" vehicle operators to exclude from taxable gross receipts any bridge, ferry or other tolls. Warren also approved a bill permitting chauffeurs' licenses to be issued immediately to youths of seventeen years and over, enabling them to drive school buses until six months after the war. A third measure approved today prohibits "chasing" fire trucks closer than 300 feet and operation of a vehicle within the block where fire apparatus has answered a call.

Bullock Agrees to Defend Ontiveros

Joseph J. Bullock, veteran criminal lawyer, announced yesterday that he will defend Frank Ontiveros, young Redwood City shipyard worker charged with the murder of his wife, Martha. Bullock recently emerged from retirement to defend Frank Alcalde, who was found guilty of the murder of Bernice Curtis. Ontiveros' preliminary hearing, scheduled to take place today before Justice of the Peace Hugh Mullin in San Mateo, was postponed indefinitely on Bullock's plea yesterday that his son, Joseph Jr., was home on Army leave, and "I want to spend all my time with him."

Luer, 78, Packer, Weds Clubwoman

LOS ANGELES, May 25. — (AP)—Albert O. Luer, 78, packing company president, and Mrs. Estela Roath, Los Angeles club woman, were honeymooning in northern California today. Their marriage last Thursday in Santa Barbara was made known here yesterday by Albert T. Luer, son of the packer. The elder Luer's first wife died four years ago.

Jewish Welfare Workers To Get Reports Today

Workers in the 1943 annual appeal of the Jewish National Welfare Fund will hold their first report meeting this afternoon at the Concordia-Argonaut Club. They will receive reports on the first three and a half days of the campaign, and plan for a continued effort. Robert M. Levison, campaign director, will preside.

"Returns thus far indicate a generous response to our appeal," Levison said yesterday, "but far more must come in before we can even approach our tremendous needs. Givers must realize that this is a united campaign for forty-five national and overseas agencies

Sears Point Road Closed

Section West of Highway 40 Out of Use for Repair Work

EXAMINER BUREAU, SACRAMENTO, May 26.—The State division of highways announced today a portion of the Sears Point road will be closed to traffic tomorrow, remaining closed until repair work on a 3.1 miles stretch is completed.

Closed stretch will run from the Sears Point Junction with U. S. highway 40 to a point four miles west.

The division said motorists wishing to use western portions of the Sears Point road may go through Vallejo by turning off U. S. highway 40 or using the old route from the Napa Y to Vallejo, thence following Tennessee Street north.

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
