By a letter dated October 10, 1958, Armstrong Cork Co. terminated the patent license dated August 23, 1956 from Johns-Manville Corporation effective as of December 31, 1958.

Johns-Manville Corporation - Inter-Company Agreements

Customary annual extension.

Minnesota Mining & Manufacturing Co.

Patent License of August 30, 1955 amended by a Supplemental Agreement dated July 11, 1958 reducing royalty payable by Johns-Manville Corporation from 8% to 1% for period January 28, 1958 ending December 31, 1958.

Pont-a-Mousson (Hoclain, S.A.)

Technical assistance agreement of May 9, 1947, as amended May 31, 1949, amended June 4, 1958 to include metal parts for J-M's "Sanacoustic" in return for an annual royalty of 5% of Hoclain's F.O.B. factory cost price thereof.

GENERAL CONTRACTSBaldwin-Hill Co.

By an agreement dated July 18, 1958, Johns-Manville Sales Corporation will sell to Baldwin-Hill Co. its requirements of certain Drilled Insulating Board Tile as more fully provided therein.

Owens-Corning Fiberglas Corp.

By an agreement dated May 13, 1958, Johns-Manville Sales Corporation agreed to sell to Owens-Corning Fiberglas Corp. a minimum of \$600,000.

Simpson Timber Co.

On June 3, 1958 Simpson Timber Co. granted to Johns-Manville Corporation and its wholly-owned subsidiaries a non-exclusive patent license to make, use and sell fissured ligno-cellulose acoustical tiles in return for a royalty of 2% of the net sales price thereof, subject to an annual minimum royalty of \$2,500.00.

TEMPORARY FILES

Anserit S.A.

By an agreement dated February 6, 1958, Johns-Manville Corporation agreed to enter into certain technical assistance and stock purchase agreements with Civilit-Industria de Artefatos de Cimento-Amianto S.A. of Brazil relating to certain asbestos braided and woven products and packings as more fully provided therein.

Derivados de Asfalto S.A.

By an agreement dated February 6, 1958 as amended June 11, 1958, Johns-Manville Corporation is granting certain technical assistance relating to Cuban manufacture of certain asphalt products as more fully provided therein.

Dyfoam Corporation

By an agreement dated June 23, 1958, Johns-Manville Corporation acquired certain options from Dyfoam Corp. relating to purchase of foamed polystyrene products and patent licenses as more fully provided therein.

Silux S.p.A.

By a series of agreements dated November 13, 1958 and November 20, 1958, Johns-Manville (Overseas) Limited and Johns-Manville Corporation entered into arrangements in Italy for the manufacture of certain refractories by Silux, S.p.A., staffing of an office by Tecnologie Industriali S.p.A., and purchase of stock of Silux as more fully provided therein.
