Dear Dr. McConnell:

Our further contact with the Mine Organization confirms the desirability of postponing the proposed Asbestos and Munro Mines survey until later in the year.

Although production operations have begun at the Munro location, it has not yet reached what is considered a normal basis either from the standpoint of volume or usage and at Asbestos, the new dust shed, a portion of the dust control program, will not be completed until Fall of this year.

Rather than set a definite date at this time, I will plan to follow-up with the Mine Organization in approximately 3 months to determine the status of the operations and establish a schedule for the surveys. I will, of course, keep you advised of the developments.
