Thank you very much for your memorandum of June 27 in reference to the use of tarpaulins for covering Ethyl drums on steamships.

I quite agree with you that the use of tarpaulins interferes with proper inspection of drums to determine leakage. We should, therefore, discourage the use of same.

Since the requirement of tarpaulin for drums stored temporarily in places other than at regulation blending plants has been taken out of the new regulation booklets issued by the Medical Department, it seems to me that there no longer exists any difference of opinion in this matter.
