As we discussed, there should be a tie or reference betw en the Technical Data Sheet and the Material Safety Data Sheet. This language should be in bold print and separate from the disclaimer. I suggest one of the two following sentences:

"THE DATA CONTAINED HEREIN IS FOR GENERAL INFORMENTAL PURPOSES ONLY, PLEASE REFER TO THE CONOCO CHEMICALS COMPANY MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET FOR SPECIFIC COMPLETE INFORMATION REGARDING THIS PRODUCT"

"FOR DETAILED INFORMATION REGARDING THIS PRODUCT PLEASE REFER TO THE CONOCO CHEMICALS COMPANY MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET."

While the legal and enviornmental groups would prefer the first statement, there may be some negative impact on the sales effort. Either statement will surfice as long as bold reference is made to the Material Safety Data Sheets.
