Dear Stan:

I am sending herewith a series of papers, some of which contain data, and some of which are to demonstrate to you just what part of the job of putting out information has been accomplished. I have been surprised, myself, at what has been published. My end of this job has not been completed, as, for example information about the subjects. Incidentally, I have not been able as yet to find the material put together by the various doctors who were responsible for the guidance and supervision of the subjects. All of this material was in a single file which was in the hands of Dr. Garner until he shifted his office to the new Medical College Building. He left it here in the medical offices of the Kettering Laboratory, from which it seems to have disappeared. This, I'm afraid is partly my fault for not having gotten it into my own hands on Lerner's moving. I still hope to find it but too many hands have moved things about lately, and I shall have trouble catching up with this item. In any case, I have additional things to say about the subjects and I'll get at this shortly and send it to you.

I'm dreadfully sorry that my failure to do my own work (for whatever reason) has presented you with such problems for which I do not wish you to be upset. You will have to do what you can to ~~put~~ together the data. Yours is not the responsibility for interpreting them and for making satisfactory use of them. I have already done part of this, as you can note. I shall have to publish my own ideas as to the parts not yet published, and I am preparing now to do this.

It is time that you should finish up your work on this project as rapidly as you can and make whatever preparation you can for pursuing your own career for unless you do this to your and your wife's satisfaction I shall be or shall have been responsible for your inability to do so. I cannot have this on my conscience. I have caused sufficient impairment of your affairs up to this point and I do not want to burden you more, for I deeply appreciate your help.
