Subject REVIEW OF CORPORATE SAFETY COUNCIL MEETING - MARCH 24, 1980

In reviewing the items relative to the agenda for the Corporate Safety Council meeting held March 24, 1980, I find the following corrections which should be called to your attention:

On page 4, paragraph 3, under D. Governmental Affairs, the statement, "During the nine years OSHA's been in operation, only five carcinogen standards have been issued," is not correct. Referring to OSHA General Standards, 1910.1000, the following substances are listed:

- 1910.1001 - Asbestos
- 1910.1003 thru 1910.1016 - Fourteen Carcinogens
- 1910.1017 - Vinyl Chloride
- 1910.1018 - Inorganic Arsenic
- 1910.1028 - Benzene
- 1910.1029 - Coke Oven Emissions
- 1910.1044 - 1,2 - di bromo - 3 - Chloropropane
- 1910.1045 - Acrylonitrile
