After Pierce DuMar received my letter of July 15th he phoned for additional information, which I in turn discussed with you by telephone. He requested the addresses of Dr. Fairley and Dr. Drummond and said he already knows Dr. Hogge of New Zealand. I gave him Dr. Fairley's and you said you would look through your correspondence for Dr. Drummond's address, which you will send either directly to Mr. DuMar or to me.

JAPAN

You repeated that you have not heard anything from Dr. Keiji Akatsuka. Inasmuch as C. D. Carter had the preliminary talks with him, I agree with you that we should do nothing until Nick can pick up this matter again when he returns from vacation next Tuesday. By a copy of this letter I am suggesting that he get in touch with you, and then you and he can decide the next step so as to allow early shipments of TML to Japan.

SINGAPORE & MALAYA

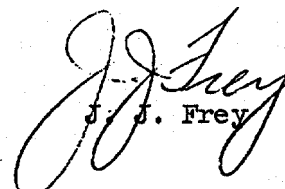
You told me that you had no current medical liaison in this area and therefore the only procedure would be for you to check with Associated Ethyl's medical department to see if they can supply the names of the proper people. If this is possible, you will write to those people from Cincinnati. Since I talked to you, Mr. DuMar has informed me that Stanvac's interest in TML for this area is less imminent, and he therefore suggests that nothing be done at this time.

PHILIPPINES

As far as I know, the Caltex refinery in the Philippines is the only one using TEL. Some years ago Associated made the first delivery. As I understand it, even now that shipment has not been consumed because the gasoline requires little or no TEL. We expect to supply the new refineries of both Stanvac and Filoil Refining Corporation when they come on stream in the near future, and therefore we will need a medical consultant there. Nick Carter visited the Philippines on his last trip and may have current information on the local doctor involved with TEL. If he does not have that information for you, presumably it will be necessary to follow the same procedure as for Singapore.
