The Massachusetts State 16-Yard Singles Championship was won by L. A. Gridley, president of the Springfield Trap Club, shooting the Climax shell. Gridley carried away the honors with a score of 196x200.

From Prescott, Arizona, comes the news that a Climaxion, George Peter, of Phoenix, was high over all at the Arizona State Shoot. During the four days' shooting, Peter not only shattered 645x650 16-yard targets, but broke 95x100 doubles and made a straight run of 254 besides.

And California broadcasts the fact that a fourteen-year-old boy, Glenn G. Cooper, tied the winner of the California Handicap with 95x100 birds to his credit. Cooper reached the top from among 168 contestants, and this young champion, like old champions, shoots the Climax shell.
