Dear Mr. Dodge:

Thank you very much for letting me go over the
file in this case, which I am returning herewith.

Until you have the relationship of the plaintiff
to the defendants at the time of the alleged injury, from the
defense standpoint, more definitely established than the file
would indicate, as well as the lack of definite medical testi-
mony as to the history of plaintiff's physical disability and
his present condition, and the opinion of your medical men as
to whether there is any traceable connection between the pres-
ent condition of the plaintiff and the alleged negligence of
the defendants, it would seem to me inopportune for you,
Mr. Hall and myself to have a meeting and discuss the advisa-
bility of a settlement.
