- Keep container tightly closed.
- Emptied container may contain residual vapors or liquid which may ignite or explode. Do not cut, puncture, or weld on or near the container. Until containers are thoroughly cleaned, keep tightly closed.
- Loosen bung before heating drum.
- Store at temperature above 72°F to prevent crystallation of product.
