Attached you will find revised copies of
 Section XIII and Section X of proposed license under Toohey
 Patent.

The adoption of the revision in Section XIII per-
 mits the elimination of Section V in draft of September 4.

With reference to the third clause on the first
 page, this would now read as follows; (if language discussed
 on the telephone is adopted.)

"Whereas, Tulloch is desirous of obtaining the ex-
 clusive license to make, use and sell, and the ex-
 clusive right to license others to make, use and
 sell materials and products embodying, employing
 or containing the invention patented by said Letters
 Patent, which materials and products are hereinafter
 referred to as the "Licensed materials".

This does not limit the materials and products
 referred to as "Licensed Materials" to any specific list.
 Exhibit A does have such a list but it seems to me to be drawn
 in such form as to be quite broad.

I will appreciate your comments when you have had
 an opportunity to examine this.
