Dear Dr. Kehoe,

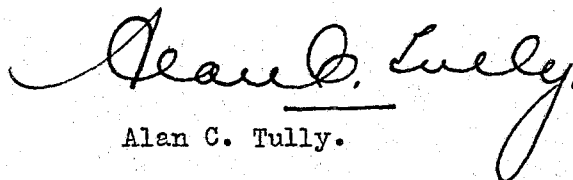
I have your letter of April 26th in regard to the return of your book entitled EXPERIMENTAL STUDIES ON LEAD ABSORPTION AND EXCRETION.
