Dear Al:

When you were here on September 17, 1969, we discussed skin tests on an enamel and you were given the following samples: No. 6237 Package A, No. 6238 Package B, and No. 32035 Thinner for use in cleaning up. Prior to each application, mix 9.2 g Package A with 1.0 g of Package B and allow to stand for 15 minutes before using. The test should be carried out just as it was on the previous paint test. The liquid mixture is applied to an area of skin one-inch square and allowed to dry. This exposure is repeated every day for 15 treatments. Following a two-week rest period, a 48-hour challenge test is to be done. The estimated cost is \$2500.00.

We should appreciate knowing the date this test is started.
