Dear Dr. Maddox:

The analyses of the urine and blood samples for lead at the Kettering Laboratory have been reported to me. The concentration of lead in the urine sample was 0.205 mg. per liter; the specific gravity was 1.027 and the volume was 47 cc. The concentration of lead in the blood was 0.085 mg. per 100 grams by the spectrographic method and 0.075 mg. per 100 grams by the dithizone method.

These values confirm the other evidence of lead exposure of a degree sufficient to cause lead poisoning.
