I've been through the two boxes of Westinghouse dioxin/furan documents (a pretty shabby collection, by the way). The only ones with Roger (R.E.) Wills' name on them are the following (first number is post-it note number, second is your bates number):

169 (785200 ff.): Cover letter for Materials & Manufacturing Technology memo # 1058 August 12, 1981, Proprietary Class 2, The formation of chlorinated furans and dioxins from burning of PCBs, sent to R.E. Wills et al. (reports on G.E. "informational seminar" May 20, 1981, Rappe presentation on CDD and CDF formation from PCBs and chlorobenzenes, confirming CDF formation from burning PCBs, but CDD only when chlorobenzenes present. Significant levels of CDFs formed from PCBs, up to 25% of PCB 1254 and 1260 converted to furans). [Several duplicates of this document in various stages of incompleteness; this one's complete.]

#30 (786111): March 22, 1983 R&D Center to Darnell Bacon, cc: Roger Wills, re: PCDD, PCDF formation from "an arc" or PCB fire.

#51 (786318-322): April 26, 1985, R.A. Kerns (Westinghouse) to Julie Bright, Indiana Board of Health, cc: R.E. Wills, jr., Gateway, re: PCB concentrations in Stout's Creek, company position there should be no dioxins because dioxins were not used at the Bloomington facility, and the PCB levels are "acceptable."

#69 (786654-57): June 22, 1976 Research Lab to "research laboratories" including R.E. Wills, transmitting attached Science magazine article.

#101 (787189-193): August 25, 1985 Sharon, MMT to Roger E. Wills et al, re: trip report (attached) on trip to Midwest Research Institute (MRI) to discuss combustion of tetrachloroethylene (Wecosol non PCB transformer fluid)-- work MRI was doing under an EPA contract, appears Westinghouse was trying to talk MRI into changing wording of its report (e.g., discusses eliminating mention of dioxins in opening statement of MRI report.)

#110 (787358-360): Dec. 6, 1984 Cracknell (Westinghouse) to Gulf States Utility Co., re: MRI data on tetrachloroethylene (Wecosol), with Jan. 6, 1986 EPA memo attached by paper clip;

these refer to #101 above, without Wills' name on them.

#131 (787991-996): March 5, 1984 "(W)" Building room 1895, to "PCB Study Team" including R.E. Wills, attaching EPRI 12/7/83 update on PCBs.

That's all I could find. Most of the documents in these two boxes are EPA records and published studies, nothing corresponding to the stuff Westinghouse it says it didn't destroy.

Do you have copies there of the above? If not, and you need them, let me know quickly, I could fed-ex copies in the morning or fax them late tonight.
