The ATSDR/EPA proposed program included separate developmental, reproductive, and neurotoxicity studies. The program as initially proposed by ATSDR/EPA would have cost the industry approximately \$1,400,000 (study and administration costs).

** The molecular research program (James Swenberg, University of North Carolina) and risk assessment activities are estimated to cost \$70,000. These programs will be supported by the 1995 surplus.
