Thought

• If BP has a ^{4-yr} linear trend as does
BPb then the time related behavior alone,
would enhance the the correlation - even if
no BPb & BP existed. Suppose independently of each other -
then trends would enhance a spurious correlation, which
may eliminate the other 30 sig. variables.

- Reason for removing time effects.

• Correlation vs BPb relation

If a strong
BPb & BP relationship exists
it will show up within
the 30 sig. variables.
