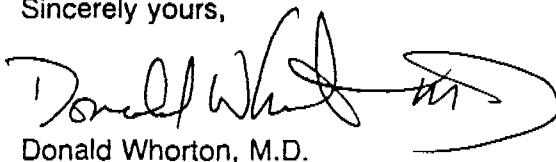
I will establish my own medical practice and consulting business and will be moving to new offices in July. Until that time, I can be reached at ENSR.
