Subject May Summary Of Personnel Dosimetry Results

Listed below are the personnel dosimetry results for the month of May. A total of 275 samples were taken using the gas bag method for an eight hour TWA. Area sampling of non-regulated areas are also included in the results.

The results are as follows:

.0 - 1.0 ppm VCM	- 266	96.73%
1.0 - 5.0 ppm VCM	- 7	2.55%
5.0 - 25.0 ppm VCM	- 2	.72%
+25.0 ppm VCM	- 0	.00%

Two more people were exposed to more than 5.0 ppm VCM. Their names, job titles, work experiences and monitoring results are listed below.

Eddie Ridings, Maintenance Mechanic, 20.0 ppm VCM. This employee was involved with removing the condenser head on D-400 reactor. The employee was wearing a continuous flow mask.

Gordon Ostrowski, Large Reactor Operator, 13.9 ppm VCM. This employee was probably exposed while draining water from the South VCM Receiver and the Blowdown Tank. He was wearing a continuous flow mask while performing this job.

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
