OLD BUSINESS

1. Dowtherm fumes and smoke in Dowtherm control area.

Union said seals are leaking and new packing is needed. Management said that they will have this situation taken care of.

2. Skin burns from batches.

Management said nothing new has been tried, although the new batch has been better, from comments around the plant.

3. Cars rolling out of cylinders just before closing doors.

Management states they will investigate to see why the track gauge to hold the cars in are not being used.

4. Dust collector throwing out excessive amount of dust in parking area.

Management has worked on the dust collector, and will try to eliminate this problem.

5. Union wants a type of Georgia buggy that isn't so hard to handle, suggested a new type of buggy.

Management said they will check into new type that fits on front of lift trucks.

6. Union again requested oil leaks from prehardners and mixers be fixed.

Management said some have already been repaired, and others will be.

7. Union said roof leaks around blower on No. 2 Line, and warehouse, also in mold area.

Management said the roof people will be in to repair all these leaks.



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8. Warehouse people want bonus meeting.

Mr. Amos said they will have the meeting this week.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Union says that molds cannot be tabled properly at the beginning of No. 2 Line.

Management will investigate this problem to see what can be done.

2. The Union protests the fact that some crew leaders are carrying themselves like supervisors.

Management said although they must instruct, "they are crew leaders".

3. Spray booths much too misty.

Management said they will try to eliminate this problem.

4. Union asks for more lighting on receiving end of roto-blaster in mold area.

Management said this will be done.

5. Enclosure around desk in mold area.

This will be looked into.

6. Union protests the fact that the utilityman must handle 100 lb. bags by himself.

Management will check into this.

7. Union said there are too many spacers and other metal objects thrown into the Kaylo. This is very dangerous to other workers in the plant, like trim saw operators. This is carelessness.

3. Union asks for revaluation of roto-blaster in mold shop.

Management said this will be investigated.

3. Union asks for boots for men going into prehardners.

Management said that they will issue boots to each crew.

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10. Union asks if anything can be done with floor plates by the discharge end of prehardner.

Management will investigate this problem.
