SUBJECT: KODARAS AIR EROSION TESTS

GENTLEMEN:

I HAVE JUST HAD A CALL FROM MIKE KODARAS THIS AFTERNOON, CONCERNING NEXT COURSE OF ACTION RELATIVE TO THE AIR EROSION TESTS THAT HE IS SUPPOSED TO RUN FOR US. THE EQUIPMENT IS COMPLETELY SET UP, ALL OF THE APPENDAGES HAVE BEEN ORDERED AND ARE IN PLACE, AND THEY ARE READY TO GO. HE IS AFRAID THAT IF WE DO NOT ACT QUICKLY, WE MAY BE A LITTLE LATE FOR G.S.A., AND THAT HIS OWN OUTFIT MIGHT LOSE INTEREST IN THE PARTICULAR TESTING PROGRAM. CONSEQUENTLY, IT IS IMPORTANT THAT WE DISCUSS THE SITUATION AND DETERMINE IMMEDIATELY WHAT SAMPLES ARE TO BE TESTED BY KODARAS. IF NECESSARY, WE COULD HAVE A SHORT MEETING ONE DAY THIS WEEK, AND THEN CALL MIKE KODARAS AND GIVE HIM INSTRUCTIONS. OTHERWISE, IT IS ENCUMBENT UPON HARRY WILSON TO CONTACT THE OTHER MEMBERS OF THE TECHNICAL COMMITTEE, AND FOR US TO COME UP WITH AN IMMEDIATE COURSE OF ACTION, SO THAT WE DO NOT LOSE THE CHANCE WHICH WE WANT TO EFFECT WITH G.S.A. ON THE AIR EROSION SPECIFICATIONS.
