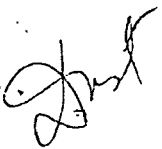

My dear "Jeff":

I suppose you have received from
Mr. Mitchell a copy of Dr. Lanza's letter regard-
ing taking Xray pictures of our employees by the
United States Department of Health.

In view of this letter, you may ad-
vise the Public Health Service that they may
take the pictures, with the understanding that
they are not available for any purpose whatever
except public health information, and you want
to stress the fact that we do not want them giv-
en to shyster lawyers and doctors so as to be
the subject of suits, for, as you know, we have
had enough adjustments for any one company.

We are perfectly willing to help
them in every possible way, but they in turn
must help us so far as they can legally do so.
